## President Chamisa Assures Resettled Farmers And Landowners Of Security And Ownership

GWERU - In a resounding speech delivered to thousands of people at the campaign launch in Gweru, Citizens Coalition for Change (CCC) President Nelson Chamisa addressed concerns over his stance on land ownership.

This came in response to false accusations made by propagandists suggesting that Chamisa intends to dispossess those who acquired land through Zanu PF's land reform programme.

With passion and conviction, President Chamisa categorically denied these false

claims, stating that his mission is to unite the nation, not to sow division.

He affirmed: "We are not here to divide the nation. Some have already begun spreading a false narrative that those who acquired land through the land reform programme will be dispossessed. That is not true; do not believe these lies."

President Chamisa went on to reassure the crowd that, under his leadership, landowners will be granted full ownership rights through the provision of title deeds.

He emphasized that these title deeds would not be designed

to favor any political party, but rather to ensure the complete ownership and security of the land for the settlers.

He emphasized, "When we assume power, we will provide title deeds to ensure that you have complete ownership of the land, not a partisan title deed. We want you to feel secure wherever you have been resettled."

Furthermore, President Chamisa highlighted ongoing cases in various parts of the country, such as Chilonga, Mutoko, and Uzumba, where citizens are being deprived of their land.

He vowed that under his

leadership, such injustices would not take place, stressing: "Under our leadership, citizens will not be deprived of their land, as is occurring in locations such as Chionga (Mutoko, Uzumba, and numerous other places across the country)."

The promise of title deeds for resettled farmers and landowners was met with resounding applause and cheers, indicating the importance of land issues in the hearts of the people.

His address at the Mkoba Stadium in Gweru served to assuage fears and dispel rumors surrounding his land policies.

President Chamisa's commitment to uniting the nation and ensuring secure land ownership provides a glimpse into the priorities and promises of his presidency, if elected.

In a time when land ownership remains a contentious issue in Zimbabwe, Chamisa's words carry weight and significance.

## President Nelson Chamisa Vows To Fix Zimbabwe's Economic Crisis

President Nelson Chamisa has promised economic prosperity and an end to corruption as he launched the Citizens Coalition For Change campaign (on Sunday) for national elections set for August 23.

The President is running against 80-year-old Mr Emmerson Mnangagwa, who has led Zanu-PF since a coup ousted President Robert Mugabe in 2017.

The Change Champion In Chief launched the "For Everyone" campaign in Gweru - vowing to fix the country's unrelenting economic crises.

President Chamisa lamented the lack of development in the country - saying there was little to show after 43 years of democracy.

"All we see is poverty, unemployment and millions going to the diaspora," the President said - in front of thousands of cheering supporters gathered at Mkoba Stadium.



Cheerful Change Champions clad in the party's yellow regalia braved chilly weather to attend the Star rally - following sustained efforts by the police and judiciary to ban opposition party rallies.

"They have been banning our campaigns, but no one will ban us from people's hearts,"

President Chamisa said to thunderous applause.

The President promised to deal with endemic corruption and misuse of the country's resources by the ruling elite, adding that the mineral-rich country should benefit all.

This is President Chamisa's

second bid for the presidency and first under the banner of the CCC, which launched early last year.

In 2018 - he became Zimbabwe's youngest-ever presidential candidate, narrowly losing to Mr Mnangagwa in the disputed poll.

President Chamisa said the

Citizens would remain vigilant against electoral malpractice.

"We will not accept a rigged election this time," he said, promising other reforms including improved salaries for the civil service.

The upcoming general elec-

tion is expected to be close, with both Mr Mnangagwa and President Chamisa enjoying support across the country.

President Chamisa plans to take his campaign to the countryside in an effort to win over historically Zanu-PF voters.

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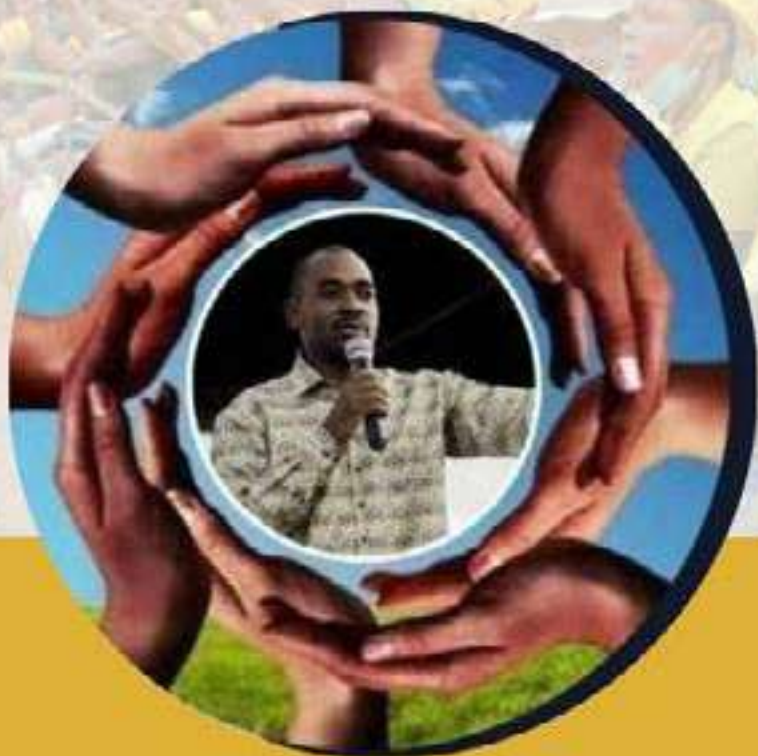

### Citizens' Action For Change Bull Challenge: All The Details

Citizens Action For Change (CAC), a group of citizens both locally and abroad mobilizing funds to support Advocate Nelson Chamisa's candidature, has embarked on another fundraising endeavor by auctioning a bull generously donated by a Murehwa farmer, Mr. Mushayabasa. The donation from Mr. Mushayabasa aligns with the President's call to support the deployment of polling agents in the upcoming elections.

CAC has been actively raising funds since January 2022 and has successfully accumulated a sum of \$334,000.

These funds are dedicated to voter mobilization efforts and the defense of the vote. Mr. Mushayabasa's contribution arrived at a critical juncture, as CAC intensifies its fund-raising campaign by reaching out to farmers and businesspeople across Zimbabwe.

The rules of the auction are as follows:

■ Participate in the auction with a \$25 donation as the entry fee.

■ You can participate as an individual or as a group.

■ Make a donation on the link <https://citizensactionforchange.org/fund/chamisa-defend-the-vote-fund-using-#BullChallenge> and add the team name in the comments section of the donation link.

■ Capture a screenshot of the receipt and submit the receipt to the inbox of the organization's Twitter handle, @citizensactionz.

■ The donor will keep the receipts until they are asked to hand them over to the judges.

■ This challenge is open to every citizen; you can enter the challenge as an individual or a group. At no time will



groups be allowed to merge.

■ The auction commenced at 10 p.m. on June 11, 2023, and will continue until 10 p.m. on July 22, 2023.

■ On the final day of the auction, July 22, a series of activities will take place to determine the winner.

The proceedings of the final day are as follows:

■ Participate On Twitter Space event to be held on July 22, 2023. The event will run the whole day and serve as a platform for participants to follow the proceedings.

■ At 10 p.m., a 15-minute deposit window will open, during which the auction judges will conclude the bidding process.

■ Once the deposit window closes at 11:15 p.m., the auction judges will tally their figures and cross-verify them with the bidders.

■ Finally, at 11:30 p.m., the auction judges will announce the winner of this remarkable fundraising initiative.

To actively participate and stay updated with the auction progress, it is essential for participants to be present at the designated Twitter Space event on July 22, 2023.

The event will provide an opportunity to engage with other participants and witness the thrilling culmination of the auction.
